Dear Prime Minister

Bradford & Bingley (B&B)

I refer to the letter received from your Correspondence Unit (CU) dated 24-08-2018 in reply to my letter sent to you on the 21 August 2018. The reply has no reference, an indecipherable signature and fails to address my request for an independent inquiry into the destruction of B&B by the European Commission and the UK Government in 2008. I also requested your personal acknowledgement of my letter and realising the demands on your time asked that it be passed to the appropriate Minister for action.

The CU letter states that my letter to you is being forwarded to HM Treasury, this is entirely inappropriate as the inquiry will relate to the misfeasance of the HMT, the Bank of England and the Financial Conduct Authority, the Tripartite, which was a main cause of the banking crisis in 2008. Furthermore, my wife Irene Blundell has made a claim of misfeasance, D03YP018, against the Tripartite at Leeds County Court in respect of the B&B rights issue completed in August 2008, the Government Legal Department has applied for a postponement of the hearing on the 6-09-2018 to which Irene has agreed. The misfeasance of the Tripartite was a main cause of the banking crisis and the destruction of B&B in 2008 so one fails to understand why my direct request to you has been passed to HMT.

After ten years B&B share and bond holders still do not know why their company was destroyed in 2008 despite numerous FOIA requests to the ministers and government departments responsible. When a Government confiscates the property of its citizens without reason, explanation or compensation, particularly when it may be seen to have failed in its duty of care to savers and investors by not adequately regulating the companies involved in the banking crisis, then all concepts of fair and honest government are devalued.

I repeat my original request, 'I would appreciate confirmation of your support for an independent inquiry into the collusion of the European Commission and the UK Government in the destruction of B&B in 2008.
